

**OFFICIAL RAFFLE RULES AND CONDITIONS:
Saskatchewan Community Foundation – Hardy Concert (“Raffle”)**

OFFICIAL RULES: By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of **Saskatchewan Community Foundation**, which shall be binding and final as to all matters related to the Raffle. The Raffle is operated under Provincial Lottery License No. **TBD** and is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and local laws.

PRIZES: The raffle winner receives 50% of total raffle sales from that day only; prizes do not include proceeds from other concerts. (“Prize”).

ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER: From 6:00pm February 12, 2026 to 9:30pm February12,2026, raffle tickets are available for purchase by anyone regardless of their residence if tickets are purchased in person at the concert from volunteers selling via handheld terminals or at kiosks on the concourse. No online sales available. All sales will end prior to the headliner for the concert at 9:30pm.

Any members of the organization, immediate family, or people involved in the conduct and management of the raffle are not allowed to purchase tickets. Must be 18+ to play.

PURCHASING RAFFLE ENTRIES: The following prices and corresponding “ticket numbers” are available for purchase: **3 tickets for \$20, 20 tickets for \$50, 50 tickets for \$100, and 200 tickets for \$200.**

NUMBER OF RAFFLE TICKETS: There will be 100,000 tickets for purchase, with the ticket prices and amounts available for purchase are as follows:

- 3 for \$20.00
- 20 for \$50.00
- 50 for \$100.00
- 200 for \$200.00

Total possible prize value of \$50,000.

THE DRAWS: A 50/50 raffle and draw will be held on February 12, 2026. All draws will take place at SaskTel Centre; 3515 Thatcher Ave; Saskatoon, SK S7R 1C4 before the headliner takes the stage at approximately 9:30pm. The winning ticket is drawn electronically by random number generator approved by SLGA. The winning ticket number will be announced over the public address. Ticket must be presented to claim prize and the number on the ticket must match the random generated number. The winning number will also be posted online at www.sask-5050.ca. The winner will also be contacted by phone if they do not claim their prize at the event.

The winner will have 365 calendar days from the draw date to claim their prize. If the prizes go unclaimed beyond their hold date, the prize shall be donated to a charitable beneficiary approved by SLGA in accordance with Section 13(d) of the SLGA's Terms and Conditions.

DETERMINATION OF OFFICIAL WINNER(S): Saskatchewan Community Foundation shall have the sole discretion to determine whether each Potential Winner is an official winner of a Prize (an “Official Winner”). The Saskatchewan Community Foundation’s decision concerning the identity of all Official Winners shall be final and binding. To become an Official Winner: (1) a Potential Winner must be eligible to participate in the Raffle under

these Official Rules and must not be in violation of these Official Rules as determined in Saskatchewan Community Foundation's sole judgment; (2) that Potential Winner must claim the prize by the deadline specified above.

The winner must provide his/her name, address and phone number with picture identification to claim the prize. A scan of a valid provincial or federal photo identification card (i.e., driver's license, firearm possession permit, passport, etc.) is acceptable.

AWARD OF PRIZE(S) TO OFFICIAL WINNER(S): A Prize will be awarded to the Potential Winner who has been awarded by the Saskatchewan Community Foundation as an Official Winner. The winner's name will be published. All prizes will be awarded to the Winner via cheque or electronic transfer. For security and auditing purposes, no cash payments will be made to winners. Unclaimed prizes will be held in a secure location for one year past the draw date. If prizes are still unclaimed, the prize/cash will be donated to a charitable beneficiary approved by SLGA.

GENERAL CONDITIONS: The Released Parties (defined below under "RELEASE OF LIABILITY") are not responsible for: (1) Entries which are stolen, lost, damaged, illegible, given away or no longer in the purchaser's possession, (2) Entries that have been or may have been tampered with or re-sold in violation of these Official Rules; (3) Entries or payments that are delayed, misdirected, undelivered, not fully captured, or garbled as a result of any failure or problem whatsoever with the availability, functionality, operability or use of any network, server, ISP, website, computer, telephone, cable or satellite modem or connection, hand held mobile device or any other computer equipment or connection, whether or not caused by site users, tampering, hacking, or by viruses, worms, or malfunctions affecting a network, server ISP or any equipment or programming used in or associated with the Raffle; (4) any other errors of any kind, whether human, typographical, printing, mechanical, or electronic in nature, which relate to or are connected with the Raffle (collectively, as described in clauses (1) through (4), "Errors"), including without limitation Errors in Raffle-related materials or in the administration of the Raffle, such as Errors in processing Entries, identifying Potential Winners, determining Official Winners, or announcing or delivering Prizes; or If any portion of the Raffle is compromised, in the Saskatchewan Community Foundation's sole judgment, by a virus, worm, bug, non-authorized human intervention or other causes which, in Saskatchewan Community Foundation's sole judgment, corrupt or impair the administration, security, fairness or proper play of the Raffle, or the proper submission or capture of Entries (collectively, a "Compromising Event"), then the Saskatchewan Community Foundation reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to guarantee or seed jackpots (with the approval of SLGA), to suspend, modify or terminate the Raffle, and to select winners from all eligible, non-suspect Entries received before the known occurrence or discovery of such a Compromising Event. All changes to the license must be approved by SLGA. All Entry purchases shall be final, and no refunds or replacements will be issued by the Saskatchewan Community Foundation. The Saskatchewan Community Foundation's sole and final decision on admissibility of entries and the determination of prize winner.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY: Entrants, by participating in the Raffle, agree that the **Saskatchewan Community Foundation** and Tap 50:50, each of their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, partners, and advertising and promotion agencies, and all of their respective officers, directors, employees, representatives, shareholders, members,

consultants and agents (collectively, the "Released Parties") will have no liability whatsoever for, and shall be held harmless by entrants against, any liability for injuries, losses, cost, expenses or damages of any kind, including damages for death, personal injury, property damage.
